This statement is Key Travel's first statement against modern slavery and human trafficking for the financial year 1 October 2018 to 30 September 2019.

There are no known issues of Modern Slavery in our business operations or supply chain.

Our Company Purpose is "To help others do good in the world" and one of our core Company Values is Compassion. This purpose and value intrinsically links to our commitment to Human Rights, to Employee Rights and to our opposition to Slavery and Human Trafficking.

As a small, but growing business, we do not meet the criteria whereby we are required to have a Modern Slavery Statement.


However, to demonstrate our commitment to ensuring that there is no slavery or human trafficking in any part of our operations, in 2019 we voluntarily took action to create this Modern Slavery Statement and to agree to an action plan for implementation in Financial Year 2020 to further our efforts in this area.

The 2020 Financial Year Modern Slavery Plan includes:

- Creating a Code of Conduct that includes an Anti-Slavery Policy
- Communicating this policy to all employees and suppliers
- Ensuring that new supplier contracts and those coming up for renewal contain Modern Slavery clauses
